What the Licence Allows You To Do

PPL is a music industry organisation collecting and distributing airplay and public performance royalties in the UK on behalf of over 3,500 record companies and 40,000 performers. It was setup in 1934 by the record industry to grant licences for the broadcasting or playing of sound recordings such as CDs, tapes and records in public

The licence covers sound recordings and is quite distinct from the *PRS for Music* Licence which covers the lyrical composition of music and is collected by *PRS for Music* on behalf of composers. Some common examples of music use requiring both licenses are:-

- Discos/end of term parties
- Dance, aerobic classes
- Background music e.g. record, tape or CD players
- School fetes
- Telephone systems music on hold

The majority of schools have some extra curricular use of recorded music and therefore require this licence.

Any infringement of copyright can be pursued and can lead to civil proceedings.
