PRS FOR MUSIC COPYRIGHT LICENCE FOR SCHOOLS APPLICATION FORM

By law a *PRS for Music* Licence is required whenever copyrighted music is used in schools in a noncurricular manner. We have highlighted below some common types of school music use where a *PRS for Music* Licence is required:

- Discos/end of term parties
- Carol concerts
- Concerts (not including musicals)
- Karaoke
- Music on hold on telephone systems
- Playing a radio/tape/CD player
- Please note that for the use of pre-recorded music (tapes, records or CD's) a Phonographic Performance Ltd (PPL) Licence is required **in addition** to a *PRS for Music* Licence.

Any infringement of *PRS for Music* copyright will be pursued by the *PRS for Music* Copyright Protection Office and could lead to civil proceedings.
